

4.0 Business Arising:

- 4.1 Second meeting on the topic of mental health and addictions
- 4.2 Focus of this meeting is on the organizations who deliver supportive services for people experiencing mental health issues in the community.
- 4.3 In small groups, LHIG members reviewed a scenario about an individual seeking care for a mental health issue and/or an addiction. Each small group had an envelope of pieces of paper with programs, services, and supports that could be accessed. They were asked to chart a patient journey for the individual in their scenario. They were also asked to provide their thoughts about these questions:
 - How do you see the role of community organizations in relation to the health system's role?
 - Are there ways that this could be enhanced to assist in addressing access and transition issues?
- 4.4 Small groups shared their patient journeys and answers to the questions.
- 4.5 In the large group – LHIG members were asked:
 - What would it look like if more services for mental health and addictions were located in the community?
 - How can the general public help with issues of mental health and addictions?
- 4.6 Staff shared what the next steps would be. Draft report will be shared with LHIG members in December. Will confirm when report will be presented to the WRHA Board.
