Highlights:

- The percentage of residents aged 12 years and older (both sexes) in the Winnipeg Health Region (WHR) who were found to have low self-esteem was slightly lower than that for Manitoba (10.9% and 11.5% respectively) however, this comparison was not statistically significant.
- The percentage of residents aged 12 and older who had moderate self-esteem was 41.3%. A similar rate is reported for Manitoba.
- The percentage of residents aged 12 and over who had high self-esteem was 32.7%. A similar rate is reported for Manitoba
- The percentage of female residents aged 12 years and older in the WHR who were found to have low self-esteem was slightly lower than that for Manitoba females however, this comparison was not statistically significant.
- The percentage of male residents aged 12 years and older in the WHR who were found to have low self-esteem was the same as that for Manitoba. This comparison was not statistically significant.
- Fewer male residents than females residents in the WHR were found to have low self-esteem however, this comparison was not statistically significant. The same can be said for that of Manitoba males and Manitoba females.
