It is important to note that Police District boundaries do not align with Community Area boundaries.

Highlights:

- The number of criminal code offences varies substantially between police districts. Police District 1, which includes Downtown Winnipeg, recorded the highest number of overall offences at 17918, followed by District 3 (15230).
- The least number of criminal code offences (7635) was reported in District 5.
- Of the three major categories of criminal code offences, 'crimes against property' accounted for the largest proportion of offences (approximately 74%). Included in this offence are such crimes as break and enter, theft, possession of stolen goods, fraud, arson and mischief.
