Impaired Driving Charges

Definition/Description:

Impaired driving is the number of impaired driving charges laid by police. Impaired driving is considered a risk to the individual driving, other passengers and other persons on or near the road. Impaired driving charges can be laid when there is, or is suspected, impaired operation of a vehicle, or an alcohol breathalizer test of over .08.

• The number of impaired driving charges has declined by approximately 28% from 1049 in 1998 to 761 in 2002.
