Definition/Description:

The indicator, Children at Home, refers to the total number of children living at home.

Children - refers to blood, step or adopted sons and daughters (regardless of age or marital status) who are living in the same dwelling as their parent(s), as well as grandchildren living in the same household as their grandparent(s), with no parents present. However, sons and daughters who are living with their spouse or common-law partner, or with one or more of their own children, are not considered to be members of the census family of their parent(s), even if they are living in the same dwelling.
