## Income Inequality: Median Household Income CHA REPORT 2004

## **Definition/Description:**

This indicator refers to the amount of median income of a specified group of households, which divides their income size distribution into two halves, i.e. the incomes of the first half of households are below the median, while those of the second half are above the median. Median income of households is calculated for all units in the specified group, whether or not they reported any income.
