Definition/Description:

Participation Rate refers to the labour force in the reference week, expressed as a percentage of the population 15 years of age and over.

Participation rate = Labour force X 100 Population 15 years and over (excluding institutional residents)

Reference Week - Refers to the week (Sunday to Saturday) prior to Census Day (May 15, 2001).
