Findings:

Personal Care Beds and Rate per 1000 population in the Winnipeg Health Region

PCH Beds in WHR:	5697
Rate Per 1000 Total WHR population	8.8
Rate Per 1000 aged 75+	122.9

Highlights:

- Personal care home beds should be viewed as a regional resources, regardless of where they are physically located.
- In WHR, the PCH bed ratio for residents aged 75 and over is slightly over that of the Manitoba Health planning rate of 120 per 1000 residents aged 75+.
