This indicator shows the availability and distribution of Fire/Rescue/Paramedic Services in the City of Winnipeg by location and type of service.

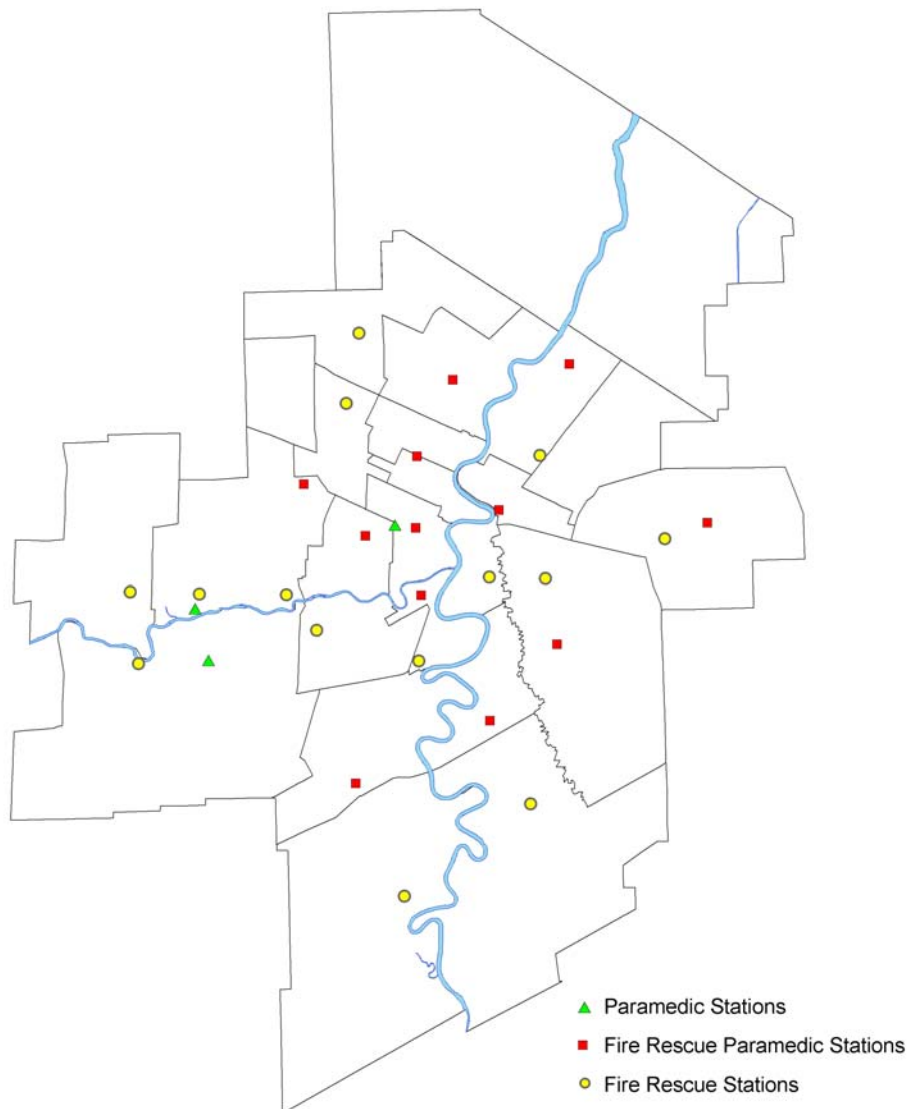

Highlights:

- Following is a summary of the number of Winnipeg's Fire/Rescue/Paramedic service sites by type:

Fire Rescue	14
Fire Rescue Paramedic	12
Paramedic	3

- It should be noted that, although not shown on the map of Fire/Rescue/Paramedic Operational Stations, there are Fire/Rescue services within the most northern locations of the WHR, 07D River East North (R.M. of East. St. Paul) and 08C Seven Oaks North (R.M. of West St. Paul). These services do not fall within the City of Winnipeg jurisdiction. River East North (R.M. of East. St. Paul) is served by a Volunteer Fire/Rescue Department with a crew of approximately 33 members. Similarly, Seven Oaks North (R.M. of West St. Paul) has an approximate 21-member Volunteer Fire/Rescue Department and a First Responder Unit. Paramedic Services are shared with the City of Winnipeg.
