



Crude Rate of PCH Admissions for Residents Age 75+ by CA of Residence Prior to Admission




# Personal Care Home Residents: Age-Adjusted Rates by CA




# Personal Care Home Residents: Crude Rates by NC

## **Highlights:**

#### Regional Rates:

- The crude rate for Winnipeg shows little change between the two periods. Winnipeg's rate in the 1999-2001 period was 121 per 1000 residents which is lower than Manitoba which showed 134 per 1000 in the same period.
- After adjusting for age and sex, Winnipeg's rate in the last period was 118 per 1000 residents down from 120 per 1000 in the previous periods adjusted rate.

### **Community Area Rates:**

- Rates vary considerably across community areas. From 82 per 1,000 for Inkster residents to 163 per 1000 for Downtown residents. There was also variability in the direction of changes. Both Transcona and Inkster experienced a decrease across the two time periods.
- After age/sex adjustment, rates range from 84 per 1000 for Assiniboine South residents to 145 per 1000 for St. Boniface residents in the last period shown.

## **Neighbourhood Cluster Rates:**

- Rates vary considerably across neighborhood clusters. From 21 per 1000 for Inkster 09A residents to 178 per 1000 for St. Boniface 05A residents. There was also variability in the direction of changes. St. Boniface 05A experienced an increase of 30 per 1000 and Inkster 09A had a decrease of 30 per 1000 across the two periods.
- After age/sex adjustment, rates range from 25 per 1000 for Inkster 09A residents (down from 60 per 1000 in the previous period) to 162 per 1000 for St. Boniface 05A residents. There was also variability in the direction of changes. River East 07D had an increase of 28 per 1000 and Inkster 09A experienced a decrease of 35 per 1000 across the two time periods.
