### Findings/Highlights:

- Within its Quality and Decision Support Division, the WRHA has a Manager of Care Maps and Audits.
- This demonstrates the commitment of the WRHA to the Care Mapping process.
- Currently, the WHRA has six Care Maps in use. These are:
  - 24-Hour Trans Urethral Resection of the Prostate (TURP) Care Map
  - Acute Myocardial Infarction (AMI) Care Map
  - Low Risk Vaginal Delivery and Newborn Care Maps (2)
  - Children's Complicated Appendectomy Care Map
  - Total Knee Replacement Care Map
- Another nine Care Maps are in authorship. These are:
  - Emergency Department Suspect Chest Pain Care Map
  - Post Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP) Care Map
  - Total Hip Replacement Care Map
  - Caesarian Section Care Map
  - Postpartum Care Map (Public Health)
  - Personal Care Home (PCH) Admission Care Map
  - Primary Care Diabetic Care Map
  - Children's Tonsillectomy Care Map
  - Emergency Department Children's Asthma Care Map
- Care Maps, either in place or under development, relate to a variety of acute hospital based programs, long term care and primary care programs, and may relate to symptom management, risk management, procedures, diagnosis or process.
- In addition, various Clinical Practice Guidelines (five in total) are in use or in development. These include:
  - Emergency Community Acquired Pneumonia (CAP) Admission Criteria, Order Form and Discharge Instructions
  - Antinuclear Antibody Testing
  - Ordering Erythrocyte Sedimentation Rate
  - Testing for Heparin Induced Thrombocytopenia
  - Monoclonal Immunoprotein Investigation
  - Beta Blocker Utilization in Elective Vascular Surgery
