

Definition/Description:

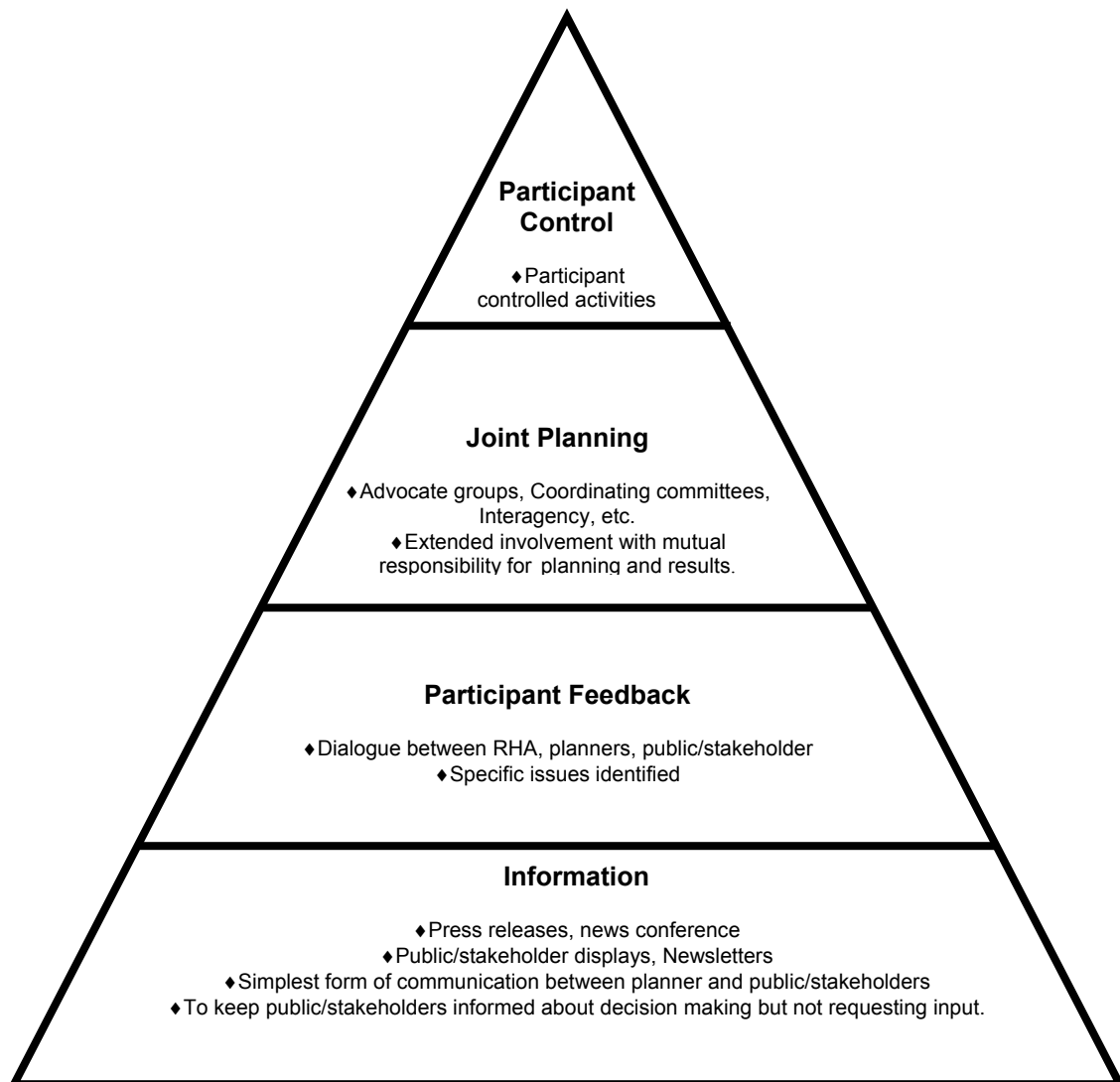
