Population Pyramids

CHA REPORT 2004

Definition/Description:

A population pyramid is a graphic representation of the distribution of a population by age and sex. The population pyramid was constructed by graphing the total number of people for each age group. We can graphically visualize the age structure by construction of population pyramid.

A population is considered old or young depending on the proportion of people at different ages. As the proportion of young people increases relative to the total, we speak of the population as growing younger. Conversely, an aging population is one in which the proportion of older people is increasing relative to the total.

Findings



Highlights:

- The Winnipeg Health Region (WHR), as of June 2003 consists of 658 579 residents.
- River East Community Area, has the largest population. Inkster Community Area has the smallest.
- Females comprise a slightly larger proportion (51.4%) of the total population. This asymetry is noticeable throughout the pyramid in all ages older than 20. (Difference is most apparent among senior age groups, which contain 19.3% more females than males. Least noticeable, with only 1% more females than males are between ages 20 to 64.)
- The base of the pyramid reflects a younger population. In the WHR this base, is small relative
 to the older age groups. This is true for all the community areas, except Point Douglas and
 Downtown, which have younger populations.
- The largest proportion of the population falls between ages 35 54, (which reflects generations commonly referred to as baby boomers, ages 38 57). This "bulge" in the population is easy to distinguish among community areas.

Senior citizens (people 65 or older)

- WHR senior citizens account for 13.9% of total population. A population with about 12% or more of its people aged 65 and over can be considered 'old' ¹.
- The proportion of senior citizens in community areas varies throughout the WHR.
- St. James Assiniboia and River Heights Community Areas contain highest proportion of senior citizens (65+) in their population distributions. (18.1% and 16.6% respectively).
- By looking at the pyramid shape of each community area, other patterns emerge. Assiniboine South Community Area has a second "bulge" which has been characterized as the echo generation, the generation born to the baby boomers.

Children

- Highest proportion of children and youth (<=19) resides in community areas Inkster and Point Douglas, 31.0% Inkster, 29.7% Point Douglas.
- The median age of the WHR population is 37 for both sexes, 39 for females and 36 for males. This number also varies between community areas, from 33 in Inkster to 40 in St. James–Assiniboia and Assiniboine South.
