

# Total Visible Minority Population (Self-Identified)

## **Definition/Description:**

The Total Visible Minority Population (Self-Identified) indicator refers to those persons who self-reported as belonging to a visible minority group. The *Employment Equity Act* defines visible minorities as persons, other than Aboriginal persons, who are non-Caucasian in race or non-white in colour.
