

Definition/Description:

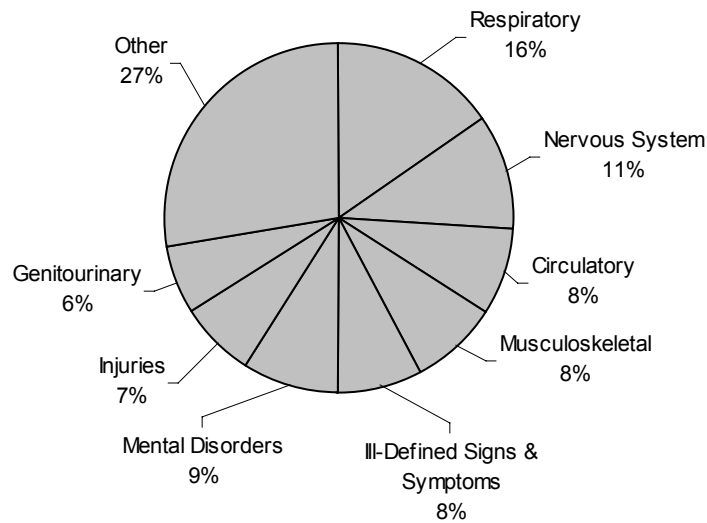

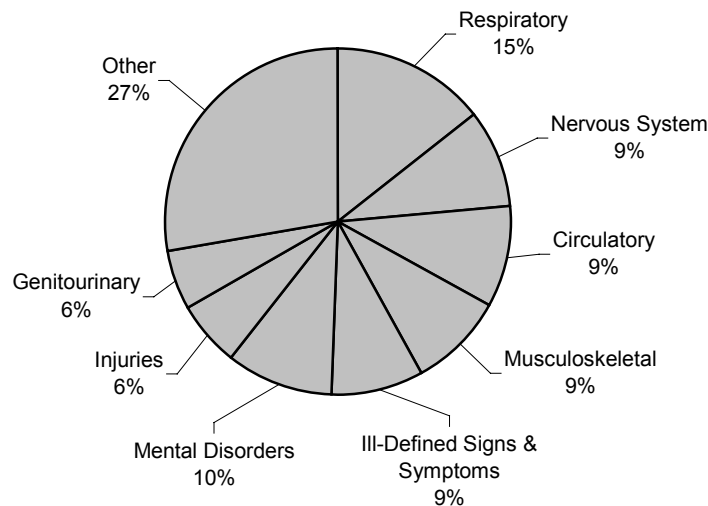

Findings:

Top Diagnoses on Physician Visits, Winnipeg, 1995/96

Highlights:

- Winnipeg's top nine major diagnostic classifications for physician visits have changed very little over time. Respiratory Illness continues to be the primary diagnosis for at least 15% of physician visits in 2000/2001. The Winnipeg distribution varies little from other Regional and Manitoba results.
