

Two measures are provided for the WHR Residents: Reasons for Hospital Care indicator.

Measure #1 Provides information based on Inpatient hospitalization.

Measure #2 Provides information based on Day Visit hospitalization (“same day” procedure treatment).

This indicator reflects those services provided only to residents living in the WHR. It does not account for those services provided in the region regardless of where people live.

Measure # 1 - Top 5 Inpatient Hospitalizations by Community Areas

Definition/Description:

Purpose of this indicator is to investigate the reason for hospital care provided to WHR residents. Hospital care can be provided to clients in two ways: Inpatient or Day Visit. This indicator shows the top 5 reasons for Day Visits based on the most responsible diagnosis.

Each Inpatient Case represents one hospital separation.

Extracted data was based on the most responsible diagnosis, and includes Winnipeg residents, regardless of their hospital location. Data are categorised by Major Diagnosis Classification (based on ICD-9-CM Code), and sorted by Sex. Excludes newborns, stillborns, brain deaths and Day Visit cases. (Day Visits: Scheduled for "Same Day" procedure, treatment.)

Top 5 Hospitalizations were ranked from highest to lowest crude rate per 1000 population for both sexes.

Information is presented at the regional and Community area levels for the fiscal year 2002/2003.

- Top 5 Inpatient hospitalizations comprise 48% of all Inpatient hospitalizations. Of those top 5, No.1 (Disease of Circulatory System) alone is responsible for 29%.
- Majority of community areas have same ranking order as WHR.
- **Disease of Circulatory System** appears to be No.1 reason for hospitalization in all community areas except Downtown, where it falls on a second place, surpassed only by Mental Disorders.
- **Disease of Digestive System** holds No. 2 place in all community areas except Downtown (as mentioned above), and River Hights CA (Neoplasms).
- **Neoplasms** are No. 3 in all community areas except St. James Assiniboia (Factors Infl. & Contact Health Services), River Hights (Disease of Digestive System), Point Douglas and Downtown. Last two community areas have Injury and Poisoning on a 3rd spot. It comes as no surprise because these areas combined comprise 29% of all Injury and Poisoning hospitalizations.
- 4th and 5th reasons for hospitalization are shared between **Disease of Respiratory System; Injury and Poisoning** and **Factors Influencing Health Status & Contact with Health Services**. Exceptions are community areas: Point Douglas (Mental disorders), Downtown (Disease of Digestive System) and St. James – Assiniboia (Neoplasms).

- Top 5 Females Inpatient hospitalizations comprise 40% of all Females Inpatient hospitalizations. Of those top 5, No. 1 **Pregnancy, Childbirth, Puerperium** alone is responsible for 68%.
- Females are hospitalized 22% more often than males. Major reason for that is female exclusive category, Pregnancy, Childbirth, Puerperium.
- **Pregnancy, Childbirth, Puerperium** is by far No.1 reason among females. This category alone comprises more than a quarter of all females inpatient cases (26.84%), and 16.32% of the total number of inpatient cases.
- Pregnancy, Childbirth, Puerperium remains No.1 in all 12 community areas. (for the females) Its Crude rate significantly varies from 22.48 in River Heights Community Area, to 41.06 in Point Douglas Community Area.
- No. 2 in the WHR for females is **Disease of Circulatory System**. That is also true for all community areas except Transcona Community Area, where it was topped only by a Neoplasms. (in St Boniface, it shares second spot with Disease of Digestive System)
- 3rd and 4th place alternate between **Disease of Digestive System** and **Neoplasms**. St. James – Assiniboia Community Area: roled them down one spot by inserting Factors Infl. & Contact Health Services on a third place. Community areas Point Douglas and Downtown are the only community areas where Neoplasms didn't make it to the top 5. Downtown Community Area also doesn't contain Disease of Digestive System in a top 5. On the other hand these two community areas are the only ones where **Mental Disorders** and **Disease of Respiratory System** are among top 5.
- Downtown Community Area has **Injury and Poisoning** in 5th place, which is unique for the females breakdown.
- The rest of the community areas holds one of these categories on a 5th place: **Disease of Genitourinary Factors Influencing Health Status & Contact with Health Services**. (St. James - Assiniboia Community Area has Disease of Digestive System)

- Top 5 Males Inpatient hospitalizations comprise 60% of all males Inpatient hospitalizations. Of those top 5, No. 1 **Disease of Circulatory System** alone is responsible for 58%.
- **Disease of Circulatory System** is the No.1 cause for hospitalization among males in the WHR. It is also true for all community areas except Downtown, where it is bumped to 3rd spot by **Mental Disorders** (No.1) and Injury and Poisoning.
- No. 2 is to the **Disease of Digestive System** category, for WHR and most community areas. (Inkster has it in a 3rd place, Downtown in 4th, and Point Douglas in 5th place)
- **Disease of Respiratory System** holds 3rd spot in WHR, and seven community areas. (In Inkster it is on a 2nd place, in St Boniface on a 4th place, and in Downtown, River Heights and St James Assiniboia it claims 5th place.)
- Unlike the female top 5 order, where only Downtown Community Area had **Injury and Poisoning** (5th place), all community areas based on males ranking order have Injury and Poisoning in one of the top 5. It varies from highest in Downtown, in a 2nd place to the lowest Seven Oaks 5th place.
- **Neoplasms** category, that didn't make it to the top 5 in WHR, holds 5th place in 6 community areas (St. James – Assiniboia, Fort Garry, St Vital, St. Boniface, Transcona and River East) and No. 3 in River Heights and Assiniboine South.
- As mentioned before, Downtown Community Area has the highest rate **Mental Disorders** (No.1), followed by Point Douglas (No.4)

- Top 5 Day Visit hospitalizations comprise 66% of all Day Visit hospitalizations. Of those top 5, No.1 (Disease of Digestive System) alone is responsible for almost 20% (19.3%).
- **Disease of Digestive System** was the No.1 reason for Day Visit hospitalizations among Winnipeg residents. It is also true for each individual community area as well.
- **Disease of Nervous System & Sense Organs** holds No.2 place in all community areas except Fort Garry, St Vital and St. Boniface. (In which case it was pushed down to the 3rd place by Neoplasms).
- **Neoplasms** are No.3 in all community areas except three areas listed above, and Inkster where it holds 4th place.
- **Disease of Genitourinary System** and **Factors Influencing Health Status & Contact with Health Services** are alternating between 4th and 5th place in all but three community areas. Downtown has swapped 4th place with Neoplasms, and Seven Oaks and Inkster have **Disease of Circulatory System** on a 5th place, unlike any other community area.

- Top 5 Females Day Visit hospitalizations comprise 66% of all Females Day Visit hospitalizations. Of those top 5, No.1 **Disease of Digestive System** alone is responsible for 17.5%.
- Winnipeg females contributed 12% more to the Day Visit hospitalizations than Winnipeg males. Part of it is due to the female exclusive category, **Pregnancy, Childbirth, Puerperium**. It forms approximately 9% of all females Day Visit hospitalizations, and approximately 5% of all Day Visit hospitalizations. Even though this category didn't make it into top 5 for WHR, there are 4 community areas with a high rate worth mentioning. Point Douglas (12.93 Crude rate per 1000 population), Downtown (12.87 Crude rate per 1000 population), Inkster (11.47 Crude rate per 1000 population) and Seven Oaks (8.35 Crude rate per 1000 population). These 4 community areas contribute 46% of all Pregnancy, Childbirth, Puerperium Day Visit hospitalization.
- No. 2 in the WHR for females is **Disease of Nervous System & Sense Organs**. That is also true for most community areas except River Heights and Assiniboine South where it's high rates caused it to be No.1 reason.
- 3rd and 4th place are alternating between **Disease of Genitourinary System** and **Neoplasms**. Women are more likely to be hospitalized due to Disease of Genitourinary System, than males. Based on a female Day Visit hospitalization every single community area, has Disease of Genitourinary System in a either 3rd or 4th place. Based on a male Day Visit hospitalizations only St. Boniface has high enough rate for this category to be in a top 5.
- **Factors Influencing Health Status & Contact with Health Services** are anchored in a 5th place.

- Top 5 Males Day Visit hospitalizations comprise 67% of all Day Visit hospitalizations. Of those top 5, No.1 **Disease of Digestive System** alone is responsible for more than 20% (21.6%).
- **Neoplasms** and **Disease of Nervous System & Sense Organs** alternate 3rd and 4th place. Pattern is upset only in Inkster Community Area where Disease of Circulatory System squeezed between them in a 3rd spot.
- **Disease of Circulatory System** is a category which rate wasn't high enough to be marked as one of the top 5 based on both sexes, but it holds No.4 place based on a male hospitalization. Based on males hospitalizations, all community areas, except St Vital have this category on either 3rd, 4th or 5th spot, while female hospitalizations, with their overall rate for this category of 4.67 couldn't make it any further than 8th place.
- **Factors Influencing Health Status & Contact with Health Services** are showing on a 5th place for overall males hospitalizations, but in most community areas it was ranked 4th. Inkster was the only one that roled it out of the top 5.
