Definition/Description:

The data signifies the number of WHR residents aged 75+ who were in a provincial PCH for at least one day, per one thousand WHR residents aged 75+. This only includes PCH beds, not federal beds, due to lack of information on federal bed use in the provincial database.

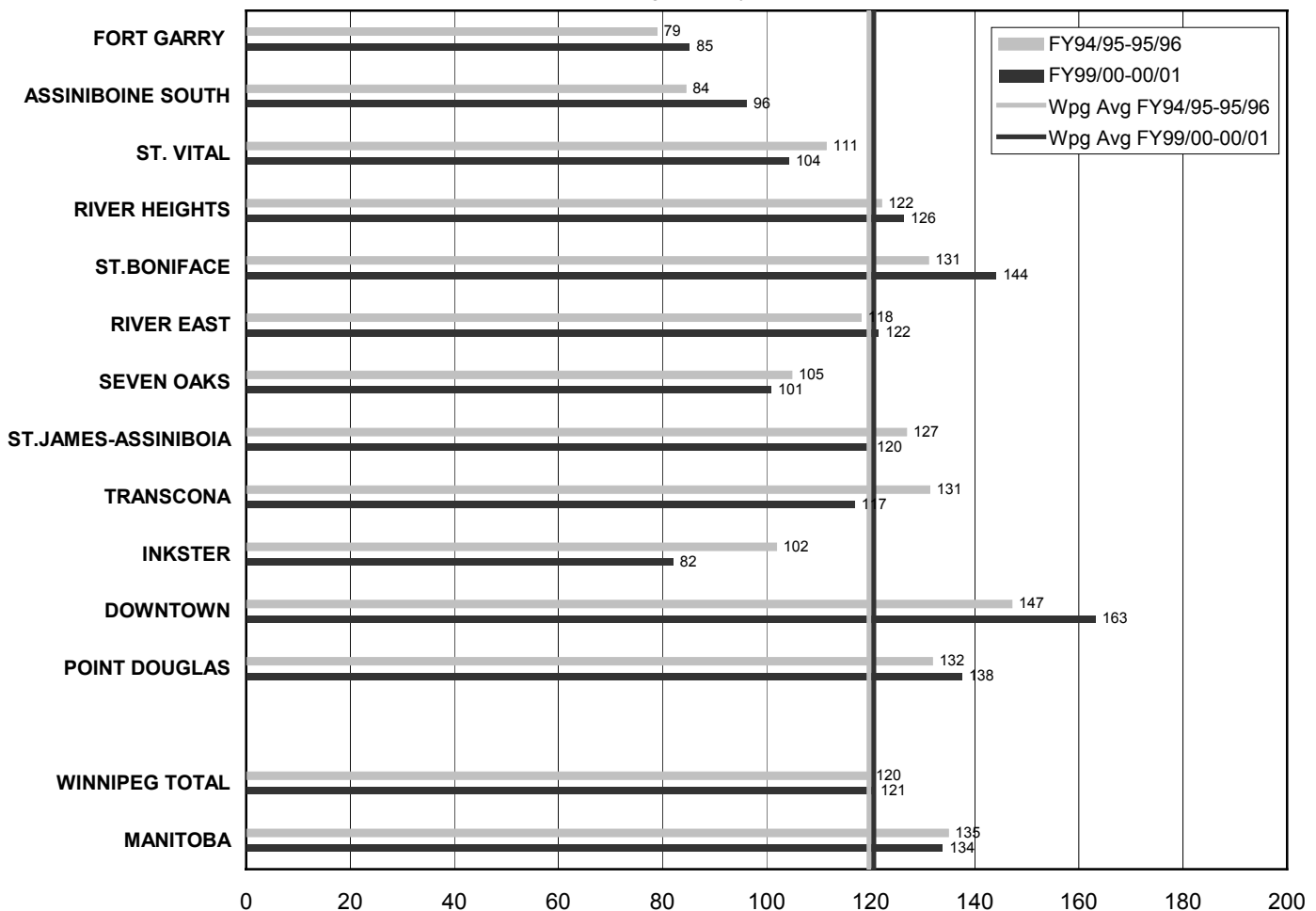

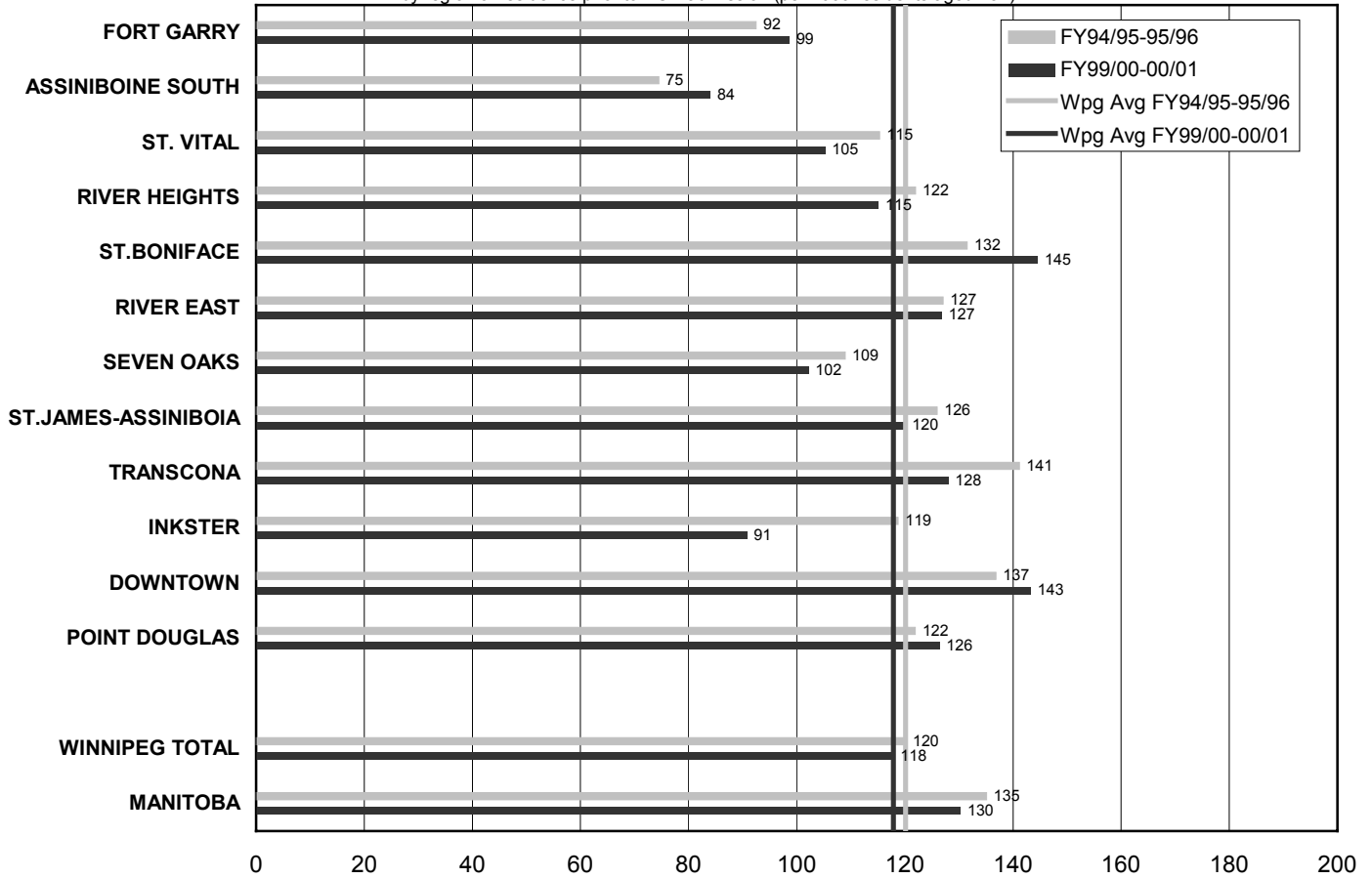
Personal Care Home Residents: Crude Rate by CA

Crude Rate of PCH Admissions for Residents Age 75+ by CA of Residence Prior to Admission



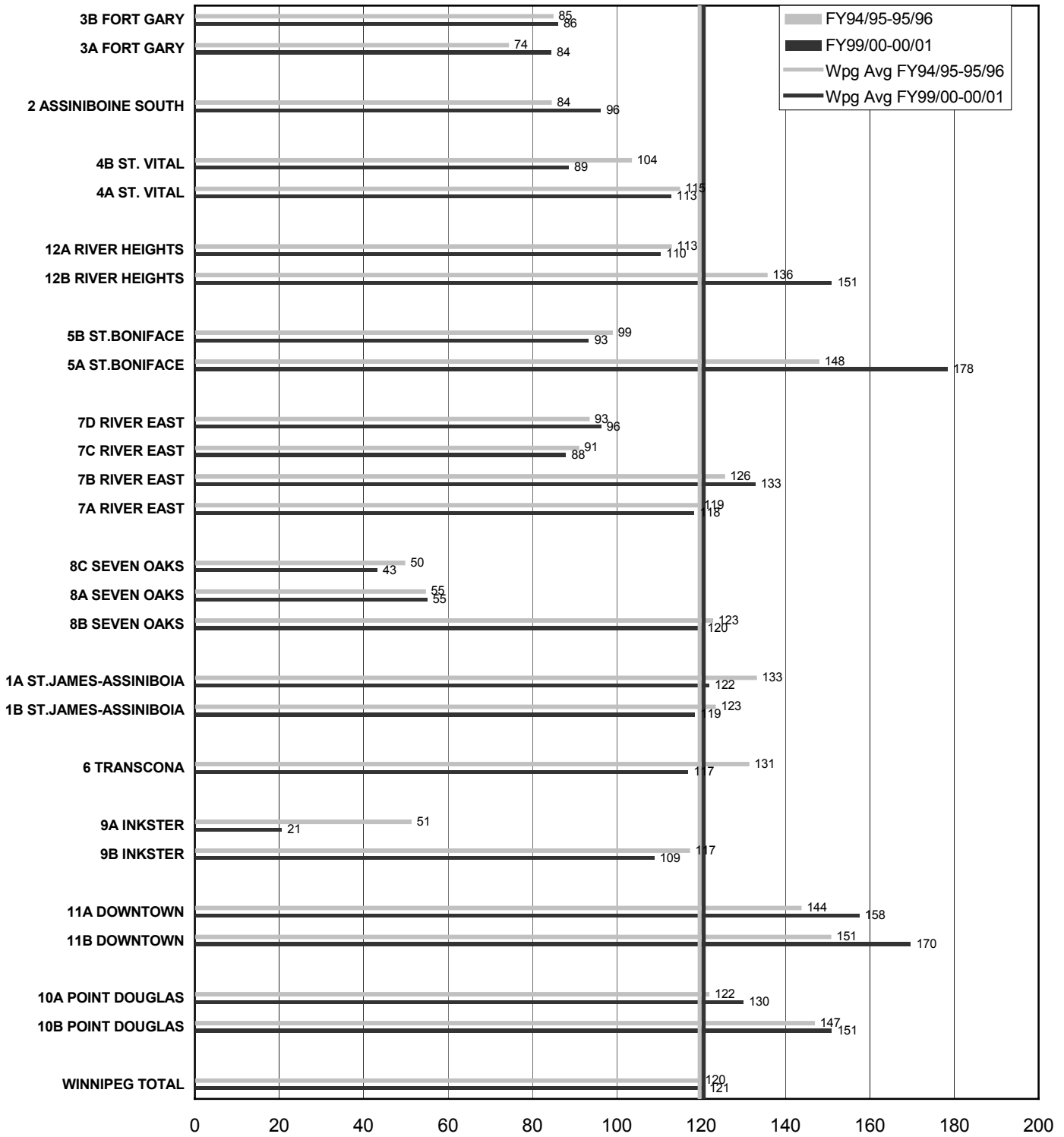
Personal Care Home Residents: Age-Adjusted Rates by CA

Age- & sex-adjusted rates of residents aged 75+ living in provincial PCH, by region of residence prior to PCH admission (per 1000 residents aged 75+)



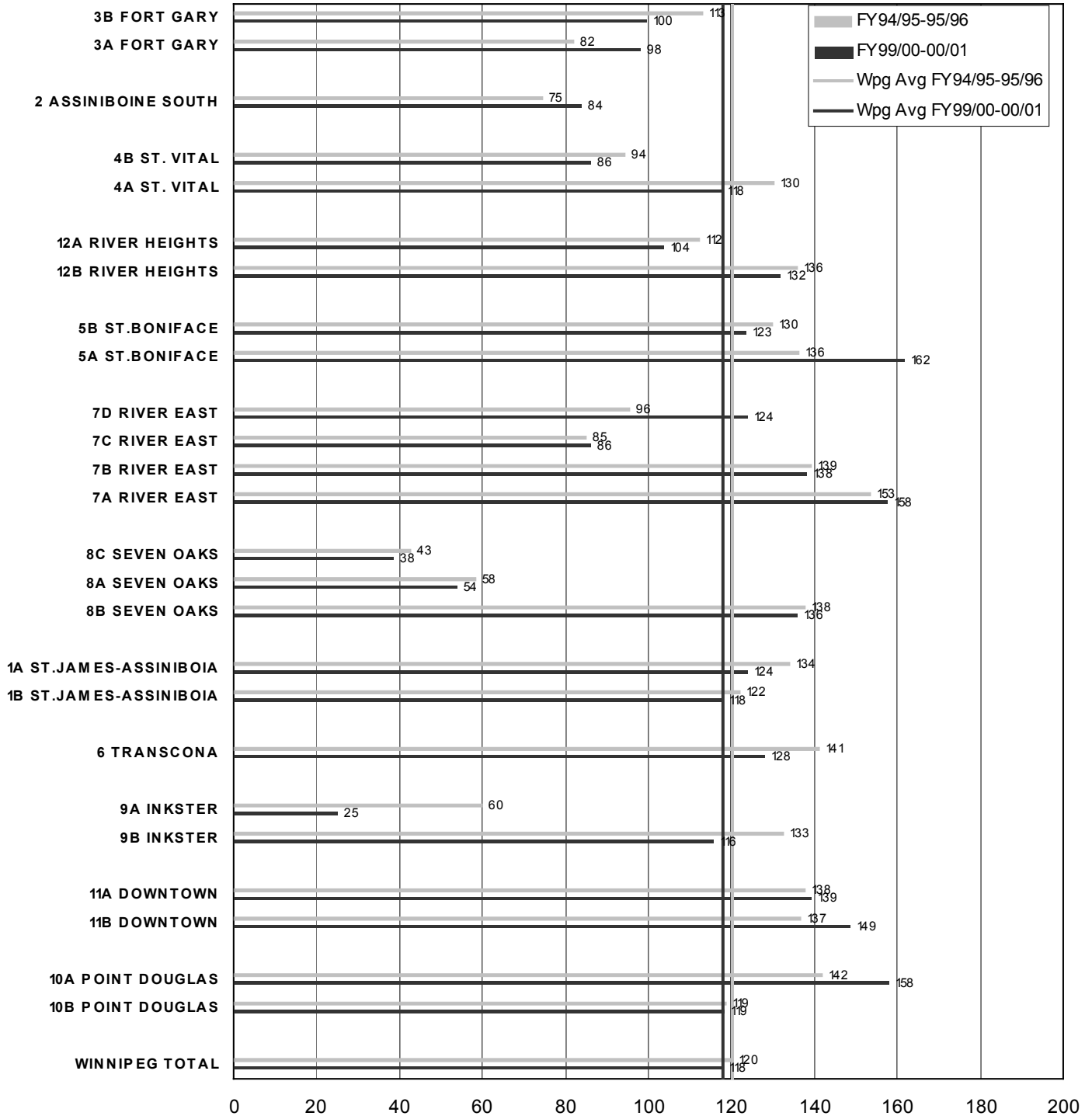

Highlights:

Community Area Rates:

- Overall Winnipeg showed a small increase in crude rates for PCH residents. Five of the 12 community areas showed a decrease in the crude rate. The greatest decrease was seen in Inkster where the crude rate dropped by 20 residents per 1000 over the age of 75. Downtown had the greatest increase among the CA's across the two periods rising by 16 per 1000 residents aged 75+.
- After adjusting for age and sex, Winnipeg showed a small decrease in the rate for PCH residents. Six of the 12 community areas showed a decrease in the adjusted rate. St. Boniface had the greatest adjusted rate in the last period showing 145 per 1000 age 75+. Assiniboine South had the lowest adjusted rate of PCH residents at 84 per 1000 in the last period shown. The greatest decrease was seen in Inkster where the adjusted rate fell by 28 residents per 1000 over the age of 75. St. Boniface also had the greatest increase across the two periods of 13 per 1000 residents over the age of 75.

Neighbourhood Cluster Rates:

- Overall Winnipeg showed a small increase in crude rates for PCH residents. Roughly half of the neighborhoods showed a decrease in the crude rate across the two periods. 5A St. Boniface had the greatest rate of 178 per 1000 residents aged 75+ and the greatest increase across the two periods of 30 per 1000. 9A Inkster had the lowest crude of all of the neighborhoods at 21 per 1000 and the greatest decrease across the two periods of 30 per 1000.
- After adjusting for age and sex, Winnipeg showed a small decrease in the adjusted rate for PCH residents. Sixteen of the 25 neighborhoods showed a decrease in the adjusted rate. 5A St. Boniface had the greatest adjusted rate in the last period showing 162 per 1000 age 75+. 9A Inkster had the lowest adjusted rate of PCH residents at 25 per 1000 in the last period shown. The greatest decrease was seen in 9A Inkster where the adjusted rate fell by 25 residents per 1000 over the age of 75. 7D River East had the greatest increase across the two periods of 28 per 1000 residents over the age of 75.
