

# Data Presentation

## Format

The following format is used to report all indicators in the Data Book:

- **Definition/Description** – A definition of the indicator and the rationale or background information is provided for each indicator.
- **Methods** – For the majority of indicators, the methodology used to generate the indicator is found in the Methods section of the Data Book, CHA Report 2004. If a unique method was used to obtain this information, then it was briefly described directly within the indicator.
- **Source** – The data source for the indicator is reported in this section. Sometimes more than one source is listed. All values, tables and figures were generated by the Population Health and Health System Analysis Team, Winnipeg Regional Health Authority unless otherwise specified.
- **Findings** – The evidence for each indicator is reported in brief summaries of the results, tables, graphs and maps in this section.
- **Highlights** – This section provides a summary of the indicator results.

## Guide

It is recommended that the reader review the methods section of the Data Book, CHA Report 2004 along with the indicator(s) of interest. Indicators are assigned into categories based on **Manitoba's Health Performance Measurement Framework** and the **Population Health Assessment Framework** (see Methods section of the Data Book, CHA Report 2004).
