Perinatal Palliative Care

Perinatal palliative care is an evolving element of comprehensive pediatric palliative care with the explicit aim to support the infant, parents and involved healthcare providers when a life-limiting condition of the fetus has been anticipated. This presentation will identify the components of perinatal palliative care. Case studies will be utilized to highlight the importance of meaningful collaboration, communication, continuity of care, and development of flexible and individualized care plans in the context of complexity and uncertainty of neonatal outcomes. Lived experiences will be presented specific to parents who have chosen to continue their pregnancies despite an antenatal life-limiting diagnosis. Relevant resources specific to perinatal palliative care for health care providers and parents will be identified.
