Bringing Palliative Care Concepts to Health Care Aides: Reflecting on 15 Years of Evolving Education

Health care aides provide support to patients in a variety of care and clinical settings. The patients they support may be individuals registered on the WRHA Palliative Care Program receiving support for a life-limiting illness. Palliative care patients have unique needs and considerations in care, that are important for all health care team members to be informed about. The nature of the health care aide role can demand efficiency in care and often an active pace. Thus, ensuring health care aides have a foundational understanding of the needs of palliative care patients, can support the provision of targeted care with limited time-enhancing experiences in care for both the patient / family and the health care aide alike. Collaboratively the WRHA Palliative Care Program and non-profit organization Palliative Manitoba, developed and launched a curriculum based educational course, providing holistic palliative care information to health care aides. Running for over 15+ years, this course supports learning in a safe and connected environment. This presentation shares the fundamentals of the course and explores future hopes for expansion.
