Interventional Pain Management for Patients Receiving Palliative and End of Life Care

Interventional pain management offers targeted treatment aiming to decrease burden of pain and improve quality of life in patients living with chronic pain. This presentation reviews the role of different alternatives and modalities for patients receiving palliative and end of life care, including ultrasound-guided single and continuous nerve blocks, continuous neuraxial blocks, chemical neurolysis and radiofrequency ablation.
