North of 53: Providing Collaborative Pediatric Palliative Care in Rural or Remote Settings

When providing pediatric palliative care to children with life limiting conditions a great degree of uncertainty can exist. Diagnoses are often rare and the exact clinical course may be difficult to predict. The Northern Regional Health Authority is one of the health authority's where collaborative care is provided with local primary care providers. The pediatric palliative care team along with other pediatric specialties are part of the circle of care that extends beyond the city borders, being involved on a consultative basis with many children who reside outside of Winnipeg. Care for these patients and their families requires collaborative planning and communication.

We will highlight the collaborative efforts undertaken to provide care for pediatric patients and their families when a palliative approach is undertaken. Utilizing case studies, we will explore the complexities that may arise while caring for families who live in northern Manitoba. We will discuss the development of individualized care plans which incorporate advance care planning discussions and management strategies for anticipated symptoms. We will highlight pediatric palliative care resources for families and health care providers.
