Day Hospital programming may be different for each person and might look different from one location to the next, however your specific needs and goals will be addressed by:

- Developing a care and treatment plan
- Offering services in person, virtually, one on one or in a group
- Determining which members of the team you will see
- Evaluating the length of time you will receive services

The health care team at day hospital can:

- Look at all areas of your life and focus on helping you to meet your personal health goals
- Teach you how to prevent falls, and exercise to stay strong
- Help you with managing at home and staying strong after a hospital stay
- Provide education and resources to help you to meet your needs at home.



The Day Hospital Team

The day hospital team is made of many different health care professionals.

This may include:

- Nurses
- Physiotherapists
- Occupational therapists
- Recreation therapists
- Dietitians
- Social workers
- Geriatric Specialist Doctors

Depending on your needs and availability, this may include:

- Geriatric Assessment
- Memory Assessment
- Education
- Walking and balance programs
- Connecting to resources
- Support after hospital discharge
- Medication assessment
- Functional assessment
- Physiotherapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Recreation Therapy
- Caregiver support and education



Transportation

You may arrange your own transportation to day hospital, or the Day Hospital Staff may be able to assist with transportation options.
