

Ebola Virus Disease Contact Investigation Tool – Calendar of Activities

Purpose: This form is intended to be used as an interview tool to elicit information from the case related to activities they have been involved with that may have exposed individuals to the Ebola virus

A close contact requiring Public Health follow-up is defined as an individual:

who has provided care to the patient (including a health care worker, family member, funeral worker, or volunteer), or who has had other close physical contact with the patient or deceased body, that may have resulted in unprotected exposure to blood or body fluids from the patient directly or indirectly through contaminated surfaces or equipment;

OR

who has worked in a laboratory handling specimens from EVD patients and may have had unprotected exposure to these specimens through the course of their work (2). ¹

Period of Communicability: **Patients can transmit the virus while febrile and transmission risk increases as the disease progresses . Post-mortem transmission also occurs. ²**
